### Development Tags

#### **New Login and Account Creation Process (ESS-9)**

The My Payentry login and account creation process have been completely redesigned. There are many new features with this version that attempt to make the enrollment process faster and less confusing for users. Changes include:

- Link Codes no longer exposed to employees, they just need to click the link in their invitation email.
- Removal of Security Questions
- Added support for Backup Recovery Codes
- Automatic Email Confirmation (If account was created from the same email address the invitation link was sent to)
- Existing Account Detection
- Employees can now login with either their username or email.
