## Development Tags

### **Added Ability to Search Job / Department Columns on the Edit Check Details Page by Code and Description ( Dev Tag 59059)**

Users can now search for results in the Job and Department columns on the Edit Check Details screen by using the code and description. Previously, users were limited to using one or the other based on their preferences.

### **Added CStoreroom as an Option to the Object Menu for Record Security ( Dev Tag 58884)**

When setting up record-level security, users will now see the 'CStoreroom' object as an available option. Please note that this should be used for record-level security only.

#### **Added Search to the 'Add an Item' Menu on the Edit Check Details Page ( Dev Tag 57894)**

The behavior of the 'Add an Item' drop-down menu has been enhanced to include a search option. When a user clicks on the menu, it will expand automatically and allow for two different types of interaction; use the arrow key to look through the list of options or start typing into the new search box in order to find the option you are looking for. Please note that you can search by code or description.

#### **Added Search to the 'Add Code' Menu on the Manual Check Page ( Dev Tag 56020)**

The 'Add Code' drop-down menu has been enhanced to include a search option. When a user clicks on the menu, it will expand automatically and allow for two different types of interaction; use the arrow key to look through the list of options or start typing into the new search box in order to find the option you are looking for. Please note that you can search by code or description.

#### **Edit Check Page to Display Active Accruals Only ( Dev Tag 58634)**

In the 'Employee Summary' section on the Edit Check Details page, we will no longer display accruals if they have an end date that is in the past.

#### **Employee Gender to Default to Blank ( Dev Tag 58629)**

Previously, if an employee's gender was not specified, the field was defaulting to a value of 'Female'. This has been fixed so that if a gender is not specified, the field will be blank.

#### **Fixed Issue with Filtering by the 'Not Set' Employment Type for ACA Coverage Bulk Update ( Dev Tag 58879)**

Previously, when trying to filter the 'ACA Coverage Bulk Update' results by employment type, the 'Not Set' option would not properly show employees with employment type set to 'N/A.' This has been resolved.

#### **Fixed Issue with the Calculation Error on Employee Labor Allocation ( Dev Tag 58779)**

Previously, the employee labor allocation calculation was including end dated records. This would result in a warning that the employee was overallocated, even if the sum of their active records was less than or equal to 100%. Moving forward, the calculation will only look at active records.

### **Fixed Issue with the Save and Close Button on the Employee ACA Coverage Page ( Dev Tag 58874)**

When adding a new 'Employee ACA Coverage' record, the Save and Close button was not closing the window properly. This has been resolved.

### **New Enter Wages Page is Now Default for New Users ( Dev Tag 59029)**

Any newly created users will default to the 'new' Enter Wages page when clicking the Enter Payroll Wages button. For the time being, users do still have the option to explicitly choose to use the 'old' Enter Wages page if needed.

### **Updated the Job / Department Column on the Edit Check Details Page ( Dev Tag 58624)**

We have updated the Job and Department columns found on the Edit Check Details screen with the goal of improving user interaction. Now, when a user tabs into one of these columns, they can immediately start typing to find matching results. They can also delete the existing value within one of these columns and the full list of options will be shown in a dropdown.

### **Updated the Size of the Edit Check Details Page ( Dev Tag 58619)**

We have changed the default screen size of the Edit Check Details page. When opened, this page will now fill the majority of the available browser window. The goal was to provide as much screen real estate as possible in order to present information to the user and limit scrolling.

### **Updated Warning Message for the Nivelo Service ( Dev Tag 58949)**

For clients using the Nivelo service, we have updated one of the warning messages. The previous message stated: "There may be an issue with your company Bank Account. Please contact your customer service representative." The new message will simply read: "Please contact your customer service representative."
