Development Tags

Ability to Run Single Report Writer Report for Multiple Companies (PENG-170)

NextGen users with access to more than one company can now include data from multiple companies (only companies they have access to) within a single Report Writer Report. Please note that at this time, this functionality [will only exist](#) for Report Writer reports.

A new 'Company Selection' section has been added to the Run Report dialog for Report Writer Reports, which can be seen when a user chooses to run a new or an existing Report Writer Report. A user can choose to run the report for the currently selected company (the company being viewed in NextGen) or they can choose the Company List option. If the Company List option is selected, a list of available companies will be displayed. Note that 'available' companies are those companies that the currently logged-in user has permissions to access. This list can quickly be filtered by utilizing the search field, which will accept either company code or company name.

Above the grid, there will be a running tally of how many companies have been selected. In addition, the user can easily review only selected companies by clicking the 'Show all selected companies' link also located above the grid. At the time of this release, a maximum of 50 companies can be included in a single report.

If you would like to block certain users from having this option, you can add a DENY rule on the Interface Rights screen for a specific role. This can be found in the security section under Interface Rights > Company > Reports > Company List.

New Geocoding Service (PENG-182)

Payentry NextGen can now assist users in selecting the appropriate tax codes that should be applied to an employee's record based on the employee's home and work address with the newly added Geocoding Service.

When the Geocoding Service is enabled on a company, three new features will be made available:

1. A Tax Code Lookup button will appear on the Add New Employee screen.
 - This will provide a list of recommended tax codes when a new employee is being added to the system.
2. A Tax Setup Audit button will appear on the Employee Tax Details screen.
 - This will run an audit of existing tax codes assigned to an existing employee.
3. An Employee Tax Setup Audit button on the Company Taxes screen.
 - This will run an audit of existing tax codes assigned to all active employee within a company.

We have also added new options to the Interface Rights screen to better manage access to these buttons. You will find the following three items in the directory tree:

- System > Company > Add New Employee > Emp Tax Code Lookup
- System > Company > Payroll Setup > Taxes > Emp Tax Setup Audit
- System > Employee > Payroll Setup > Tax Details > Tax Audit
